DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS:

This position involves responsibility for the care and maintenance of grounds. Employees in this class also operate and maintain various types of motor vehicles and power equipment. Grounds-keepers work under the general supervision of a higher-ranking employee but are permitted some exercise of independent judgement in carrying out the details of the work. Specific instructions may be given for new or unusual assignments. The incumbent will perform all related duties as required.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES:

- Maintains grounds by mowing, raking, cutting, rolling, reseeding and fertilizing lawns;
- Plants and cares for trees, shrubs, and flowers;
- Operates and may perform routine maintenance on trucks, tractors, backhoes, mowers, rollers, tillers, chain saws, and other equipment;
- Removes snow and ice from walks, driveways, steps, and building entrances;
- Keeps grounds free of litter and debris;
- Collects and disposes of rubbish;
- Makes deliveries, loads and unloads materials and moves furniture and equipment;
- When not working as a Groundskeeper, may do other maintenance or cleaning work.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS:

- Good knowledge of grounds maintenance practices and techniques;
- Working knowledge of the operation and maintenance of manual and mechanical equipment used in grounds maintenance and snow removal;
- Ability to follow oral and written instructions;
- Willingness to perform physical labor;
- Willingness to work in adverse weather conditions;
- Mechanical aptitude and dependability;
