MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS:

Under the supervision of the principal or teacher, employees in this class perform routine but necessary school and classroom tasks, relieving teachers of more specialized duties. Instructions and supervision are not responsibilities of this class. Direct supervision is received from administrative personnel and teaching staff. Does related work as required.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES:

- Uses manual language with deaf students in the classroom;
- Works with individuals or small groups to review progress;
- May correct themes, compositions, standardized and objective tests;
- Fills out, copies, types or dittos forms, reports, and stencils from various rough drafts;
- Assists in routine classroom housekeeping chores;
- Organizes and participates in group games and related activities;
- Reads and tells stories to children;
- Conducts review and drill with groups and individuals;
- Receives, issues and renews library books and other educational matter;
- Attends appropriate in-service training programs and staff meetings.
